



Lohikan's 3 Day Trip to Washington, DC & Virginia!



The highlight of Camp Lohikan's Trip Program is an optional three day sightseeing trip scheduled for August 3 - 5, 2014. This summer we're heading down to Washington DC, where we'll be visiting the U.S. Capital, taking a tour of Baltimore's Inner Harbor via the amazing Seadog III, and also visiting the National Zoo in Washington, DC. An entire day will be spent in Paramount's Kings Dominion Amusement Park which is one of the BEST AMUSEMENT PARKS in the country! It's going to be an awesome 3 days!

The 3 Day Trip features: deluxe overnight hotel accommodations (with indoor pool), air conditioned coach bus transportation, all meals and gratuities, adult staff supervision, and all admission fees! The trip registration charge is \$425. The trip is limited to 50 campers who are entering the 6th grade and older.

3 DAY TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 1

We leave camp after an early breakfast and travel to Baltimore's Inner Harbor. Our first stop is the National Aquarium. Sharks, dolphins, stingrays, and tropical fish are among the more than 16,000 creatures that are featured at the aquarium. There's even a walk-through rain forest that is amazing and the live-action dolphin show is a must see. After the aquarium, we board the Seadog III for a boat tour of Baltimore's historic harbor. But the Seadog is more than just a boat tour; once in open water, this jet propelled speedboat will reach an exhilarating top speed of 32 knots. Be sure to hang onto your hat. Before leaving the harbor, we will make time for some shopping. Later that night, at the hotel, we will end the day's festivities with a pool party and pizza for everybody.

DAY 2

We will spend the entire day at Paramount's Kings Dominion Amusement Park. Kings Dominion is a 400-acre theme park that's home to more than 60 rides, shows and attractions. The park features 15 world-class roller coasters making it one of the largest coaster collections on the east coast. However, there's more to Kings Dominion than roller coasters. WaterWorks, a 20 acre water park, is located inside Kings Dominion.

Packed with wave pools, water slides and flumes and an awesome lazy river, WaterWorks is the perfect place to cool off on a hot summer afternoon. One of the newest and most exciting attractions is the Intimidator 305 roller coaster featuring NASCAR legend, Dale Earnhardt. Reaching speeds in excess of 90 mph, the Intimidator 305 is the tallest and fastest gravity driven roller coaster on the East Coast.

DAY 3

Day 3 is highlighted by a self-guided tour of the most recognizable building in the world, the Capitol Building. On our tour, we will walk through the very same corridors and rooms where congressmen have made history. After the tour, we travel across town to the National Zoo. Get your safari cap and canteen ready as you walk around a 163-acre zoological park that's home to thousands of animals from all over the world. The zoo provides unlimited opportunities to amaze, entertain, and inform through hands-on exhibits and programs that include animal training and feeding demonstrations. A zoo-wide scavenger hunt will highlight the day as teams of campers search the zoo for clues. After the zoo, it's to the bus and back to camp.
