Assumption of Risk Agreement for the Horseback Riding Activity

1. I acknowledge that horseback riding is a potentially dangerous activity and involves the risk of serious injury and/or property damage. While protective equipment and safety procedures will minimize this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist.

2. I acknowledge that: (a) risks and dangers exist in my child's participation in the horseback riding program; (b) my child's participation in horse related activities and/or riding a horse may result in injury or damage to personal property, including the potential for permanent disability and death; (c) these risks and dangers may be caused by the horse riding activity operator, camp staff members or other participants, or by accidents, or by forces of nature or other causes. Risks and dangers may arise from foreseeable and unforeseeable causes including but not limited to, horse selection, trail selected, uneven terrain, weather and such other risks, hazards and dangers that are integral to activities that take place in a wilderness, outdoor environment.

3. I understand that the activity of horseback riding is physically and mentally intense. I have instructed my child in the importance of knowing and adhering by the rules and procedures established for safety and my child has agreed to do so.

4. I hereby assume full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, death or property damage, now and forever, arising out of or related to participation and/or instruction in said course, activities, or any related horseback riding operations, whether foreseen or unforeseen.
